At a Glance



- The main entrance has 4 steps and a handrail. There is no lift and no ramp.
- There is level access from the main entrance to:
 - Dining Table
 - Haunted House escape room
 - SAWtopsy escape room
 - Merlin's Magic Academy escape room
 - Reception desk
 - Escape Lounge
 - Seasonal Cabin escape room game

Travel by public transport

- You can get to moviESCAPE by bus and train.
- Local bus services stop on Stockport Road West (B6104) at the bus stops 'Welkin Road' and 'Vernon Park'. It is approximately 5-10 minutes walk to our venue from these bus stops. Visitors are advised that Welkin Road has an unfinished surface and does not have streetlights. For further information on public transport please visit www.tfgm.com. The bus stop is 0.5 miles / 0.8 km from moviESCAPE.
- The nearest train station is Stockport. The train station is 2 miles / 3.2 km from moviESCAPE.
- Due to our location, customers are advised to travel by private car or taxi. Local bus services stop on Stockport Road West (B6104) at the bus stops 'Welkin Road' and 'Vernon Park'. It is approximately 5-10 minutes walk to our venue from these bus stops. Visitors are advised that Welkin Road has an unfinished surface and does not

have streetlights. For further information on public transport please visit www.tfgm.com.



Travel by taxi

- Many of our visitors choose to use the Uber service for transport to and from Stockport railway station. Please note we have no affiliation with Uber or any local taxi service and cannot accept any responsibility for their services.

Parking

- There is parking near the venue. The parking is less than 50 metres from the main entrance. Parking is free.
- There is a drop-off point at the main entrance. The drop-off point does not have a dropped kerb.
- From the car park to the entrance, there is level access. Welkin Mill has its own car park. Subject to spaces being available, moviESCAPE customers are welcome to park here. When spaces are not available, there is parking available on Welkin Road. Please note that Welkin Road and the Welkin Mill car park have unfinished road surfaces and there are potholes/puddles present in certain areas. This is an unfortunate side effect of being located in a very atmospheric building. There is no footpath: Welkin Mill opens directly onto the car park which is gravel/concrete. Once inside the mill, the floor is concrete and slopes down to the accessible entrance to moviESCAPE.

Arrival



Path to main entrance

From the street to the main entrance, there is level access.

Main entrance

- The door is 900mm wide.
- The main entrance has 4 steps.
- This entrance has a handrail.
- The main door is side hung and manual.
- The other entrance door is 900.00mm wide.
- The accessible entrance is accessed from the main mill entrance corridor. Turn right before going through the double doors under the illuminated moviESCAPE sign.
- The main entrance to moviESCAPE is located at the end of a corridor which is accessed through a set of double doors from the main mill entrance corridor. This entrance has 4 steps down into the reception area,
 - There is a separate accessible entrance which can be accessed by turning right just before the illuminated moviESCAPE sign inside the mill corridor.
 - There is a wheelchair access doorbell located under the illuminated moviESCAPE sign. Customers with accessibility needs who require use of the sloped access are requested to press this doorbell and a member of staff will come to assist. This is

due to an access control device fitted to the accessible entrance and a set of fire doors.

Getting around inside

Visual Impairment - General Information

Ticket/ information desk

Reception desk

- From the main entrance to the desk, there is level access. The route is 900mm wide, or more.
- The reception desk is combined with the refreshments and bar counter within the Escape Lounge (immediately inside the main entrance). A member of staff is always located in this area to assist.

Haunted House escape room

- From the main entrance to this area, there is level access. The route is 780mm wide, or more. The door is 780mm wide.
- Some display information is low, for wheelchair users. There are seats.
- Some displays have flashing lights.

SAWtopsy escape room

- From the main entrance to this area, there is level access. The route is 78mm wide, or more. The door is 78mm wide.
- Some display information is low, for wheelchair users. Some videos have subtitles.
- Some displays have flashing lights.

Merlin's Magic Academy escape room

- From the main entrance to this area, there is level access. The route is 860mm wide, or more. The door is 900mm wide.
- Some display information is low, for wheelchair users. There are seats.



Escape Lounge

- From the main entrance to the bar, there is level access. The route is 860mm wide,
- The door is 860mm wide.

Place to eat and drink

Escape Lounge

- From the main entrance to the dining area, there is level access. The route is 860mm wide, or more. The door is 860mm wide.
- To get to a table, there are no steps.
- If you need table service, staff can help you.
- The route through the dining area is 800mm wide, or more.

- There is background music.
- The table and plates have high colour contrast.
- We cater for vegetarian and vegan specific diets.
- We do our best to cater for all allergies and dietary requirements however due to cross-contamination we cannot guarantee that any products (other than prepackaged foods) are free from allergens or other ingredients.

Seasonal Cabin escape room game

- From the main entrance to this area, there is level access. There is a permanent ramp. The route is 860mm wide, or more.
- The door is 720mm wide.

Accessibility equipment

- We have a hearing loop in Reception desk/Escape lounge.
- The nearest toilet area for assistance dogs is located within Welkin Mill car park, less than 10 metres from the main entrance.
- We have an area to charge mobility scooters and battery powered wheelchairs.
